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#### About CREST

Centre for Research, Education and Social Transformation (CREST), is an autonomous institution formed by the Government of Kerala to address the collective disadvantages faced by the Scheduled and Backward communities while integrating with the globalized economy. CREST is the successor organization of the Centre of Excellence (CEx) which was incubated by the Indian Institute of Management, Kozhikode with the support of Government of Kerala from 2002 to 2008. The Governing Council of CREST that has representation from institutions like Indian Institute of Management Kozhikode, National Institute of Advanced Studies Bangalore, Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment, Thiruvananthapuram and Sree Chitra Thirunal Institute for Medical Sciences & Technology, Thiruvananthapuram is headed by headed by the Honourable Minister for the Welfare of Scheduled and Backward Communities, Kerala as its Chairman. The programmes of CREST are mainly targeted to create a larger resource pool among the disadvantaged communities of Kerala, particularly Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes of Kerala by addressing the collective disadvantages faced by them in engaging with the globalized economy.


Since its inception in 2002 the Centre has been involved with its flagship programme, the five months Post Graduate Certificate Course for Professional Development (PGCCPD). The course has been designed to provide skills to enable candidates from Scheduled communities to compete for jobs in open market and for higher studies. CREST has also been conducting an "Access Program" objective of which is to provide support to students from disadvantaged background during their higher secondary education that would help them in obtaining admission in nationally reputed institutions in India for tertiary education. CREST has been mentoring support to such students, until they finish their undergraduate program. . Ever since its inception the Centre has been striving to help young graduates from disadvantaged background to gain confidence, build competence and achieve excellence in all spheres of educational endeavour. This was achieved by building up a faculty with diverse backgrounds and capabilities, establishing professional links with a wide range of national- and state-level institutions sharing similar perspectives and by developing an academic ambience conducive to higher learning and achievement.

CREST also conducts short term orientation program for undergraduate students, particularly for students from the disadvantaged background in the IITs, NITs, the engineering colleges of Kerala and in the All India Institute of Medical Sciences New Delhi with an objective to endow the students with academic and social skills to enable them to fruitfully engage with the professional curricular and co-curricular environs of the institute. CREST has also been organizing workshop for the faculty members to enable them to be teacher-mentors who would have a better understanding of the learning needs of the students. CREST has academic collaboration with and Oslo Metropolitan University, Norway, and Swedish South Asian Studies Network (SASNET) & Toronto University, Canada. Interns from these institutions work with the students of CREST for 2-6 months.

#### Post Graduate Certificate Course for Professional Development (PGCCPD) – The flagship program of CREST

CREST has been formed in the context that SC/ST representation is very low in sectors that do not provide job reservation and they are not adequately represented in emerging sectors like IT. The programmes of CREST are mainly targeted to create a larger resource pool among the Scheduled communities to utilize the opportunities created by the growth of Indian economy. CREST is the pioneering institution in India that addresses the collective disadvantages faced by the underprivileged segment of Indian society while integrating with the fast growing Indian economy

Since its inception in 2002 the Centre has been involved with its flagship programme, the five months Post Graduate Certificate Course for Professional Development (PGCCPD). The course has been designed to provide skills to enable candidates from Scheduled communities to compete for jobs in open market and for higher studies. The five months in-house program comprises of training in Personal Development, Communication skills, IT, Quantitative & Analytical skills and Entrepreneurship Development and General Studies. Out of the forty seats available for the course, 28 are reserved for SC, 8 for ST and 4 for OEC/OBC. Admission is based on Degree level marks, and interview. Selected students are given a monthly stipend of Rs.6000 to cover their living expenses. Mentoring support is also given by interns from universities abroad, particularly from Europe and Canada. The Post Graduate Certificate Course for Professional Development (PGCCPD) has trained nearly 1400 professional degree holders and graduates from Scheduled communities of Kerala. Many of its alumni are working for reputed organizations nationally/ internationally



### Profile of the students of the 35th Post Graduate Certificate Course for Professional Development (PGCCPD)


40 students joined for the Post Graduate Certificate Course for Professional Development (PGCCPD) which began on 9th of March 2022. Of the forty students who joined for the program, 33 are girls. The five months in-house program was concluded on 8th of August 2022. Following is the profile of the students who 35th Batch of the PGCCPD program.

**Educational Qualification:** Data gathered from the students show that 50 % of the students who joined for the PGCCPD hold Masters Degree while other 50% holds just Bachelors Degree. Of the 20 candidates have Bachelors Degree; two are Engineering Degree holders with BTech. Their academic performance at entry level have shown that of the 20 Masters Degree holders, 35% has above 80% in their Post Graduate Examinations, 60% within the range of 60% to 80% and 5% within the range of 50-60%. For those who have only bachelors degree 5% has grades above 80% , 30% within the range of 50-60 % and 65% within the range of 60-80 %




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**Economic Background:** Data gathered from the students show that 68.3% of students are from economic background whose family income falling within the range of Rs. 5000 – 20000 a month. 19.5% of the students are from the family income group above 20000 Rupees a month and 12.2% are from the background of family income lower than Rs.5000 a month.



**Location:** Majority of the students are from rural background. 78% of the students are from villages, 7.6% from small towns and 14.6% from the cities. Majority of the students are from Kozhikode district.




Location of the land owned by the family 40 responses



Occupation of Male parents: Data gathered from students show that 19.5% of the male




parents are working in government, mostly as Class IV employees, contingency workers etc. 14.6% are agricultural laborers.




**Parental Education (male parent)** : Educational qualification of male parents shows that 34.1% has obtained high school education, 12.2% graduation, 17.1% higher secondary education and 24.4% primary education.


