Orientation Programme for Entry Level BTech Students at NITK

On invitation from National Institute of Technology – Karnataka (NITK) , Suratkal an orientation programme was held for students from scheduled communities undergoing first year BTech Degree course at the NITK. The objective of the programme was to improve the aspiration/ motivation level of students and learning skills. International Day of Peace

International Day of Peace was observed in CREST on September 30, 2011, with two special lectures on world peace organized for students undergoing Post Graduate Certificate Course for Professional Development there. Dr.Vankat Raman , Faculty, Indian Institute of Management

Kozhikode delivered a talk on 'Peace and Conflict Resolution'. Speaking at the occasion Dr. Vankat Raman said that globalization, despite certain positive features, do not necessarily lead to a

peaceful international order. On the contrary, it accelerates conflicts especially among the developing countries and within people inhabiting there. He emphasized the need for a pro-active approach from the people of the developing countries for building up an equitable society. Maria Magdalena Waldvogel in her lecture—on the role of women in peace building in the globalised scenario emphasized the need for women to become active participants at the negotiation table, where decisions are taken and future processes are implemented. As it is mostly women who stay at home, trying to provide basic structures by keeping up daily routines also in times of conflict, they take over key roles in society. Knowing about local conditions and being moreover directly involved in and confronted by the prevailing processes, the female part of the population can be considered as a source of reference, understanding the potentials and causes of conflict. As part of the affected community, women can furthermore mobilize others to start processes of consolidation.

KR Narayanan Memorial Lecture

The fourth Annual National Lecture in memory of Sri.K.R.Narayanan, former President of India



was delivered by Sri.Gopalkrishna Gandhi , well known author, public intellectual and former



Governor of West Bengal on November 26, 2011 Saturday at Alakapuri Auditorium Calicut. Sr. Gopalkrishna Gandhi, who is the grandson of Mahatma Gandhi, delivering the talk entitled 'Kerala and Nehru: A Continuing Dialogue' said political discourse that began in the Nehru years with the Gandhi influence over it exercising an indirect effect, continues in many forms today, both within its domestic engagements and in its dealings with the outside world. 'Dogmas and doctrines change, they do not go away. Dogmatism remains, doctrinaire ways of thinking do not let go of their stranglehold over the processes of thought. Kerala, which has produced some very doctrinaire people is, in its essential being, anti-dogmatist. It is non-doctrinaire', he said, when new dogmas and doctrines, of native and foreign origin, want to dominate our ways of life and action, Kerala will, one trusts, continue to subject them to independent analysis and examination', he said. The people of Kerala are too conscious and too aware of their right to original thinking, to fresh thinking, to the privilege of critical enquiry and re-investigation, to become hidebound, he said, adding 'their ability to question, to probe, to not accept blindly any convention, any tradition, howsoever high its auspices, is nothing short of a colossal strength'. Sri. Gopalkrishna Gandhi was welcomed and introduced to the audience by Prof.D.D.Nampoothiri, Executive Director and vote of thanks was proposed by Prof. Ashley Paul, Associate Programme Coordinator.

Peer-level mentoring workshop at IIMK
